This year brought mounting challenges to the systems meant to protect us. In response, Venice Community Housing stood with residents, advocated for equity, and built pathways to housing and belonging. We believe everyone deserves safety, dignity, and a place to call home. By standing strong together, we can create a Los Angeles where all communities thrive.

642 residents
housed in 346 units

203 permanent supportive housing units

135 affordable housing units

An additional **383** units are in development



VCH maintained a **99%**
household retention rate and
welcomed 41 new residents

New residents included: **27** families,
10 kids, **3** transition-aged youth, and
18 formerly unhoused individuals

INVESTING IN YOUTH

40 **students** found personalized academic support and enrichment through our Study Lounge After School Program

20 **students** progressed towards their high school degrees, and **5 graduated**, earning their diplomas through our Westside Youth Academy.

08 **field trips** led during Study Lounge Summer Camp
